ECFE Program/Registration Updates

ECFE Online Registration Requests for Fall Classes – August 16-18, 2024

Initial ECFE registration requests will be accepted at tridistrict.ce.eleyo.com beginning on Friday, August 16. While creating your registration request, you will be able to indicate your class preference as well as make an alternate class selection. Payment information will be required during registration, however, your payment will not be processed until your registration request is approved. Class placement (by lottery if needed) will begin on Monday, August 19. Approval email notices will be sent by Friday, August 23. Upon approval, you will receive a confirmation email and your payment will be processed.

ECFE Registrations following the initial class placement period will be accepted until classes are filled.

Alternative to Online Registration

Online registration will provide you with the most efficient processing of your registration. If you do not have access online, you may contact our main office at 651-403-8390 or 651-403-8353 to register. Please note that phone-in registrations will be placed the same week, offering an equal advantage for ECFE class placement.

About ECFE

ECFE is a program that offers parents and their children from birth to pre-kindergarten opportunities to grow and learn together in a supportive, stimulating environment. ECFE also supports families in learning to find time for one another, having fun together, being proud of who they are, and knowing they are not alone. You will find fall semester classes and more information about ECFE in this section of the brochure. Information on preschool options can be found on pages 16-17.

What are ECFE classes like?

Classes are held in the mornings, afternoons and evenings. Most sessions last 1½ to 2 hours. A typical session begins with time for parents and children to enjoy classroom activities together. Then, children play and learn under the supervision of a licensed early childhood teacher, while parents share experiences and ideas with other parents and a licensed parent educator.



What do we know about the effectiveness of ECFE?

Participant feedback and current research show that ECFE is a major resource to families with young children. It sets the stage for parent involvement and children's success in K-12 education. It has proven effective with a variety of families, and many even believe that ECFE creates more caring communities as it brings families from diverse backgrounds together around their common goals as parents. 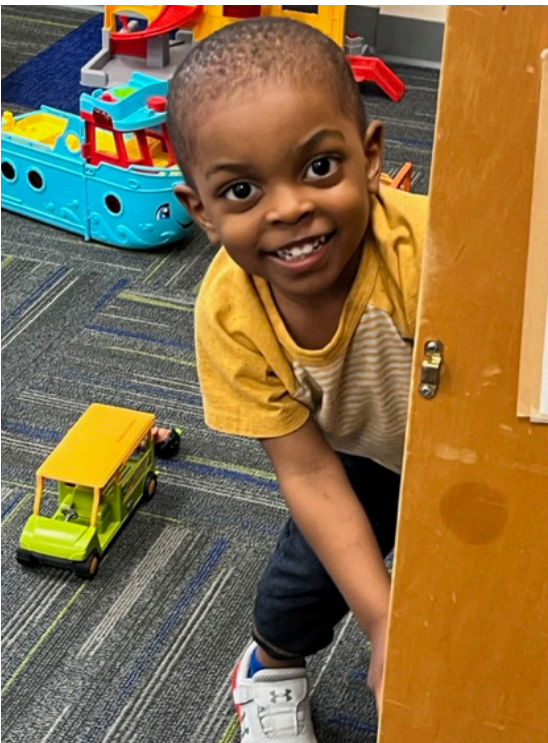

ECFE Registration

Initial registrations accepted August 16-18

Initial ECFE registration requests will be accepted on our online site at <https://tridistrict.ce.eleyo.com> from Friday, August 16 through Sunday, August 18.

While creating your account and ECFE registration request, you will be able to indicate your class preference as well as make an alternate class selection. Payment information will be required during registration, however, your payment will not be processed until your registration request is approved. Class placement (by lottery if needed) will begin on Monday, August 19.

Alternative to Online Registration

If you do not have access online, you may contact our office at 651-403-8353 or 651-403-8390 (main office) to register. Please note that phone-in registrations will be placed the same week as online registration, therefore offering an equal advantage for ECFE class placement.

Registration is for the first semester, from September 9 - January 14

- Most sections require a separate registration each semester.
- If you register online, you will receive an email confirming your class placement upon approval.
- If you register by phone, you will receive a phone confirmation by August 23. Once your registration request is approved, your payment will be processed.

Registration begins August 16 & continues until classes are filled.

Age Requirements

A child must fit within the age range specified for the class on the first day of that class

For example, to enroll in Busy Bodies (13-24 months) a child must be no younger than 13 months and no older than 24 months on the first day of class.

Class Cancellations & Refunds

Refunds must be requested at least two working days prior to the first class. Refunds are not issued after that time due to commitments made to instructors. Your money will be refunded if the class is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or if the class is filled before your registration is received. Refunds are not issued for classes with registration fees of less than \$15. No refunds are made when classes are cancelled because of weather. **A processing fee of \$10 per class may be deducted from any refund made at your request.**

Immunization Requirements

Minnesota requires that all children entering child care, early childhood programs, and elementary or secondary schools (public or private), have up-to-date immunizations on file with the provider. Children enrolled in ISD 197 ECFE programs will be required to provide a copy of an immunization record for each child enrolled prior to the child attending the program. You may use the print out from your physician's office or utilize the form provided online at www.isd197.org/parent-family-hub under Student Health and Wellness.

Please email your child's immunization record to debra.lee@isd197.org, fax to 651-403-8310 or bring the immunization record on the first day of class. Any child who does not have up-to-date immunizations on the first day of class may not be allowed to attend. For immunization questions, please call the health office at 651-403-8383.

Sibling Care at ELC Only

Sibling care is offered for most classes at the Early Learning & Family Resource Center. Care is for brothers and sisters who are kindergarten-age and younger. Siblings of children attending an age-specific class that are 6 months or older or will turn 6 months during the class must be registered for sibling care.

Due to the need to provide safe and appropriate care for all children, please register for sibling care when you register for your class. You can do this by filling out the sibling care section of the ECFE class registration online. (Sibling Care is not available for evening classes).

Recommended at age three. Required by the State of Minnesota within 90 days of school entrance and prior to kindergarten entrance. To make an appointment, call 651-403-8363.



Early Childhood Screening Minnesota Requirement for Kindergarten Entrance

Early childhood screening provides a free overview of your child's development. **The best possible time to have your child screened is about 3 years and before the 4th birthday.** During screening licensed staff will check: hearing, vision*, immunization records, cognitive and motor skills, speech/ language and communication, and social/emotional development. You will be provided with information on your child's development, and kindergarten readiness as well as other community resources. Please call our screening office at **651-403-8363** to schedule your child's appointment.

On the screening page, click the Red Button to see available appointment dates and times. If you need help scheduling an appointment, please call the screening office at 651-403-8363. In order for your child to start kindergarten in any Minnesota public school, you will need to provide the school with your child's Early Childhood Screening summary and updated immunization records.

**While screening helps the district identify children who may benefit from available community resources, vision screening, while helpful, is not a substitute for a comprehensive eye exam.*

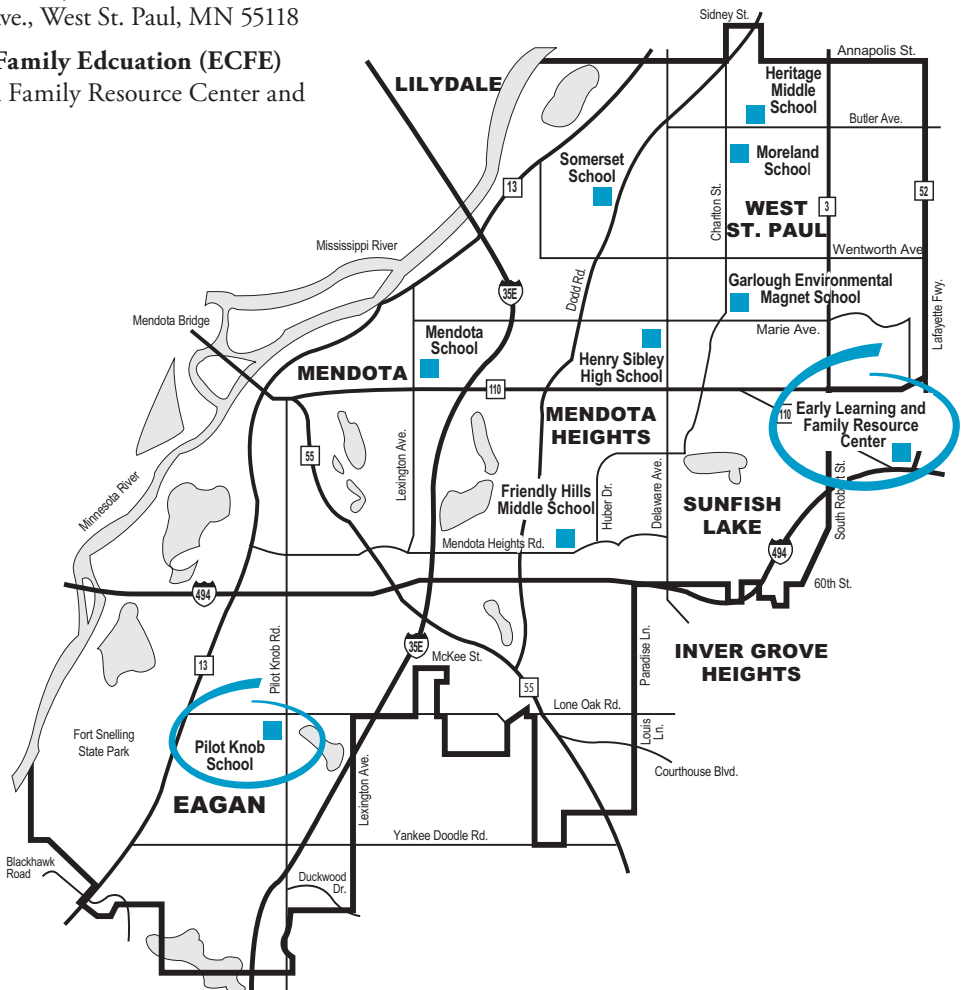
