After School Youth Enrichment:

Community Education is excited to continue our After School Enrichment, specifically for student in grades 6-12th. Beginning Tuesday, September 11th, and running through to the end of March. In this program students will have the opportunity to work with an instructor to:

1. Finish incomplete /missing assignments.
2. Improve their grades.
3. Learn to study techniques to improve their test scores.
4. Have a snack or meal on game nights.
5. Have an enrichment activity.

These sessions will be offered on afternoons when there are evening activities so students have a place to be in between school and the activity. A snack will be provided. **Students must sign up by lunch time with max of 25 students allowed per day. Doors will be locked at 3:30 every day but Wed. that day it will be 2:30. There will be no transportation available. Please make sure your child is picked up. Thank you.**

Youth Enrichment Expectations

- Be Respectful - Each student is expected to be respectful and kind to all staff, peers, and Property.
- Be Responsible - Each student is expected to bring work and all resources needed, such as handouts, text books, paper, pens, pencils, calculators, and/or laptops. Ask for help when you need it.
- Be Productive - Students should work quietly to complete their work and if they finish early allow other people the same opportunity for quiet work time. If work is finished students should read, use computer, or phone and keep a quiet environment.
- Be Safe - Students must be accounted for at all times and follow all directions from Staff.

Behavior Plan

1. Warning - Students will receive a warning to correct behavior.
2. Referred to Administration - Student will be sent to administration to set up a phone call home and will not be allowed back the next session.
3. Not Allowed Back - Student will not be allowed back in the program without teacher and administration approval.
