Our goal is for all students to meet their individual growth goal as measured by HMH Growth Measure, MAP and Acadience. Ultimately, our aim is to have all students reading on grade level by the time they complete elementary school.

Ben Hill Elementary Responsibilities:

Our teachers, support personnel, and administration will work with parents to support student success through the Science of Reading which includes phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. Some ways we will do this are:

- Provide parent workshops that are focused on increasing reading fluency and comprehension.
- Provide parents with module newsletters that reinforce the curriculum in the classroom. These newsletters contain vocabulary for you to discuss and use in conversation at home, ways you can read with your child, questioning techniques to support their continued growth, and activities you can do that support your child developing his/her reading skills.
- Hold parent conferences during the year as needed or by parent request.
- Provide student progress reports quarterly.

Parents/Guardians Responsibilities:

As parents, you agree to support your son/daughter in the following ways:

- Attend parent workshops that are focused on increasing reading fluency and comprehension.
- Read with our child nightly and ask them questions about the story you've read, in order to observe their fluency and to check for comprehension.
- Have conversations with your child about what they've read in order to promote higher order thinking skills.
- Check your child's school folder, paying close attention to their reading progress, and provide them with constructive feedback.

Student Responsibilities:

As a student, you will share in the responsibility for improving your reading fluency and comprehension. In an effort to improve your academic achievement, you will:

- Ask questions about your reading lessons to my parents and teachers.
- Read nightly with and to your parents.
- Discuss with your parents what you read.
- Practice assignments as suggested by your teacher to improve your reading skills.
- Come to school each day, unless you are sick, and participate fully in the reading lessons.
