

FAHS Seniors - Painting Parking Spots - 2024 Guidelines

Requirements to paint parking spots

- Students must purchase and supply their own paint, as well as painting materials for the activity
- Designs will only occur in parking spaces outside of the science/social studies wing
- All spots must be painted on Tuesday, 8/13/24 or Wednesday, 08/14/24 from 8am-3pm; if you are not available on these days, email koedel@freeport.k12.pa.us to schedule a different time to paint your assigned spot
- Parking passes must be purchased prior to painting. Parking passes will be eligible for purchase between 8/6/24 and 8/8/24.
- **All designs must be pre-approved by Mrs. Koedel and forms should be turned in by 8/9/24.**

Materials Needed

- All parking spots must be painted over **FIRST** with a **FLAT PAINT** base (you may use any background color you would like, but it is recommended that you paint the background in **BLACK**)
- All paint must be **LATEX PAINT** (Paint will be approved at check in table the morning of the event between 8-9am only)
- Brushes, rollers, or sponges to apply paint
- There must be a 4 inch border between your design and the lines of the parking space. **Masking tape must be used to create the border. You must provide the tape for your parking spot.**
- Designs should not exceed a 3 ft x 7 ft area
- Chalk is recommended in order to sketch out your design before applying paint

Design Criteria

- No offensive language or gang symbols
- No double meanings
- No nicknames, girlfriend/boyfriend names, etc. (ONLY your own name)
- All designs must adhere to guidelines in the FHS Student Handbook and School Board of Directors Policies and must be school-appropriate
- All Designs must be submitted 8/9/24 and approved by Mrs. Koedel
- **Your parking spot number must be visible**
- If submitted designs are not followed, disciplinary action will occur

Painting Tips

- Tape the edges of your spot with a 4-INCH margin before painting
- Do not paint on the white lines, parking curbs, or parking numbers
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot before you paint
- Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper) because there are others working beside you and you cannot step on their spot
- Bring extra plastic containers (no glass) for water and brushes
- Bring a drop cloth or plastic sheeting to put under paint cans. NO paint is permitted outside your spot
- Limit your paint palette as the quarts of paint are expensive or share colors with a friend.
- It will take 2 quarts of paint to cover the spot if you are using a solid color.

Painting Parking Spots Design Form

If you do not have a printer, you can pick up a hard copy of this form in Mrs. Koedel's office.

This design sheet must be completed in color and display the design you plan to paint on Friday, 08/09/24. **This form must be provided in hard copy only** when picking up your parking pass (and paying for it) through Mrs. Koedel between 08/06/24 to 08/09/24 (**between 7:30am-1:30pm**). Upon retrieving your parking pass, this form will be reviewed by Mrs. Koedel for design pre-approval. It would be best to take a picture of your design when painting your spot. This hard copy form will be filed in the office and not returned to you.
