

3rd-5th Grade Testing

Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s),

On July 29th your third through fifth grade child will take a MAP Growth Reading test. On August 1st your Kindergarten through fifth grade child will take the i-Ready Math test on a computer. These two tests provide scores and information to help teachers check student performance by measuring achievement and growth. Teachers use results to inform classroom lessons and set goals for students.

MAP Growth and i-Ready tests are unique as they adapt to each student's responses to measure their skill level. If a student answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. These results will provide a more complete picture of what students know and are ready to learn - whether it is on, above, or below their grade level.

Since these tests provide immediate and accurate information about a student's learning, teachers can identify students with similar scores that are generally ready for instruction

in similar skills and topics, and then plan instruction accordingly.

MAP Growth and i-Ready reports also provide data on typical growth for students who are in the same grade and subject and have the same starting performance level. Each school year, students will take these two tests in the Fall, Winter, and Spring. Following each testing period, individual student reports will be uploaded in ParentVUE so you can review these results further with your child or their teacher.

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
All families are automatically enrolled to receive **email** and **phone calls**. No sign up required!

Dismissal Procedures

Dismissal Procedures

Campus opens at 7:00am and dismisses at 2:15pm (Wednesdays at 12:15pm)

For the safety of your child, all parents and staff, we have new dismissal procedures. Please follow the guidelines below:

Parking and Crosswalk Guidelines:

- Do not park in the City of Tempe "No Parking" zones, designated by signs and cones, between the hours 7:00 am- 3:00 pm, school days only.
- Use designated crosswalks at all times.
 - After school ONLY, the east bike rack CROSSWALK will be closed.



Car Line Pick-up Procedures

- Display placards with your child's full name/grade level on your dashboard. (These will be provided by teachers at the Meet the Teacher night or in the front office)
- When picking up your child in the car line, please <u>pull forward</u> until you arrive at the loading zone.
 - Students will be loaded into the first five cars in the five designated loading zones.
 - Once ALL five cars have been loaded, they will be directed to leave.
- In the car line area, students will be seated in designated grade level or sibling zones.

Front of School Grassy Area Pick up Procedures:

- Meet your child at the designated grade level cone.
- Check out with the staff member on duty.



Attendance Line

Mariposa is equipped with a computerized telephone attendance reporting system.

The absence reporting phone number is 480-541-3801 and may be called 24 hours a day.

Parents/guardians are asked to call the attendance office by 8:00a **each** day that their child is absent. Please leave a message on the voicemail indicating the student's full name, grade, date(s) of the absence and reason for the absence. If we do not receive a parent phone call, the student's absence will be recorded as a truancy.

Parents/guardians MUST call the attendance line within 24 hours of an absence, even if they spoke to the health office, or if they told a teacher.
