# AFSA Agriscience Fair-Frequently Asked Questions

### Where do I go?

When you arrive at school for science fair, please check in at the table in the lobby. From there, you will be assigned either the gym or the study hall as your "staging area." This is where you will set up your board and answer questions from the public. When it is your assigned time to judge, science fair mentors will bring you to your assigned judging room to present your project to the judges. When you are done, return to your staging area.

### What should I bring?

You should bring 3 copies of your written report and your completed poster board.

#### What do I wear?

Please look put-together and professional. Dress pants and a nice shirt works great. FFA Official Dress is encouraged if you have it.

#### When can I leave?

You have an assigned time to be in your staging area from 3:30pm-5:30pm or 5:30pm-7:30pm. You need to stay this entire time to get credit for science fair! If you must leave for a valid reason, you and a parent/guardian must clear it with Ms.Wyatt before the night of science fair.

## Can my parents/family/guardians come?

The public is welcome to come to the staging areas, but is not allowed in judging rooms. Families are encouraged to step away from where their student is stationed to allow for more interaction with the public.

### Who are the judges?

Judges are volunteers that come from various agriculture and science occupations. They all believe in youth in agriscience and are excited to see what you know. Be sure to thank them for their time!

### When will I get results?

After the second school science fair night, the committee will meet to go over results of who will be invited to the state competition.
