Greetings, I hope you are all enjoying a beautiful Minnesota summer! The purpose of this email is to share some important back to school tasks to have on your radar as we move into August. Please note that some items may require your attention prior to the start of school.

Annual School Year Paperwork: You may now log in to [Skyward Family Access](#) to complete the annual school year paperwork. **This must be completed in order to view your child's schedule, which will be released later in August.** Completing this online paperwork also indicates that you've reviewed the [Student & Family Handbook](#) and our Internet Acceptable Use policy that is included in the handbook.

Open House: Save the date for the DIS Back to School Open House Wednesday, August 28 from 4:00 pm-6:00 pm. More detailed information will be shared later in August.

School Supplies: Click here for the [24-25 Supply List](#). For parents looking for a convenient purchasing option, DIS has partnered with [School Toolbox](#). Using this site, parents may purchase some or all of their student's supplies online to be shipped to their home. Please allow up to 10 days for shipping. Students should bring their school supplies to Open House.

Chromebooks: DIS will provide a school-issued Chromebook for every student at DIS for the 24-25 school year. Chromebooks assigned to students in 4th and 5th grades will stay at school. 6th graders will bring their Chromebooks back and forth from home and school. In order to maintain the condition of our devices, 6th graders will also be provided protective cases. Personal devices are not allowed for use at school. *Please watch for additional information regarding purchasing insurance and technology expectations in the weeks to come.*

Band Camp for Incoming 5th Graders: If your 5th grade student will be in band next year, a free band camp will be offered August 19-22. Sections will meet together Monday through Thursday mornings each day to learn all of the basics and to get started before the first day of school.
