I am sharing information regarding how a transition from a hybrid learning model to a full in-person learning model may take place. Before any transitions take place, all health and safety guidelines must be addressed. It is also vital for families to understand that the 6 feet distancing between desks has been adopted by the vast majority of public schools throughout the state.

Transitioning from hybrid learning to full in-person learning is a highly complex task. Attached are two documents. The first is an overview of the areas we are working on that need to be addressed to allow for a transition. The second is a more indepth view of our benchmarks.
