STUDENT PARKING/DRIVING REQUIREMENTS:

- Only juniors and seniors in good academic, behavioral, and attendance standing as judged by school administration -- will be allowed to drive to and park at school. "Good academic standing" is defined as passing all courses and on track to graduate from a credit perspective. Excessive tardiness, cutting class, or behavior in violation of the Code of Conduct may result in the loss of driving privileges.
- All applicable motor vehicle laws apply.
- Every driver must exercise extreme caution when entering/exiting the parking lot and school grounds. During dismissal, students exiting the lot must wait for all buses to leave. DO NOT drive between buses.
- The speed limit is 5 mph in the parking lots and 15 mph on school roadways.
- Students must park in the student parking lot unless given permission to park elsewhere.
- If driving a vehicle other than the vehicle identified above, students must obtain a temporary pass from the main office.
- Vehicles are to be locked at all times. The school is not responsible for the contents of vehicles.
- Students must remove all materials for the school day before entering the building. Once parked, a student may not use his/her vehicle during the school day without prior permission from administration.
- Student vehicles are subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other contraband may be present in the vehicle.
- Students are not allowed to leave school grounds during the day without permission from parent/guardian and/or administration. This will be facilitated by the attendance office.
- Any student illegally leaving the school building, especially when transporting another student in the process of doing so, will forfeit driving privileges for the remainder of the year.
- School administration may revoke the driving/parking privilege of a student not adhering to these regulations or the Code of Conduct at any time.
- These regulations, procedures, and consequences are in addition to and in conjunction with the parking procedures in the student handbook.

ACCEPTANCE OF RISK. I understand that Sauquoit Valley Central School District does not guarantee the security of the property being parked. In addition, I realize that the parking lot is not locked, secured or guarded, and will be monitored only sporadically.
