(a) Request Approval of the Donation in the Amount of \$120,000 for New Playground Equipment from the Cascade View PTA

A motion to approve the donation in the amount of \$120,000 for new playground equipment from the Cascade View PTA was made by Ms. Ballas and seconded by Mr. Larkin The motion carried 4-0.

Mr. Stefanson, Director of Operations said that he met with the PTA and they reviewed vendors and equipment to replace the aging playground equipment at Cascade View. The PTA raised the money and are donating it to the district to purchase the equipment. The maintenance team will take out the old equipment and scrape back the wood chips. The playground company will do the installation of the new equipment. It will be installed mid-August.

(b) ASB Budgets for 2024-2025

Tom Laufmann, Executive Director of Business Services reviewed the ASB budgets. Most of the expenditures are at the high school level. The approval for the budget will be at the regular time we approve the budget in August. Ms. Larkin asked about the positive cash flow and if it was expected to be at zero at the end of the year or do we carry some over? Mr. Laufmann said they always need some funds to carry over. ASB uses the money for some bigger trips or other big costs items. Mr. Laufmann said the end balances are going down.
