## Fostering Connections Through the 6th Grade Run Club

**W**hen Julie Gabrielson and Brandon Sieck noticed a gap in athletic offerings for Edina's 6th graders, they saw an opportunity to make a difference. In the fall of 2022, the two Edina Community Education instructors launched the 6th Grade Run Club, providing young students a chance to get active, build confidence, and forge new friendships.

"Due to the structure of athletics, students are not able to participate in the district's athletic programs until 7th grade," explained Gabrielson. "We know 6th graders are eager to get involved, so we aimed to help fill that gap with an accessible running club."

Meeting twice a week at Kuhlman Stadium, the club focuses on teaching fundamentals of running, exposure to more intense workouts, and even some competitive opportunities. But the real magic happens off the track.

"It's so rewarding to see the connections the students make, both with each other and with us as instructors," said Sieck. "Even before practice starts, you can see students interacting and forming new friendships. That sense of community is invaluable, especially for kids navigating the big transition to middle school."

Those bonds extend beyond the club, as Gabrielson has witnessed. "The students from year one will still come up and say hi when they see me around South View. The relationships they built have lasted and that is really special to me."

And the benefits extend well beyond 6th grade. Many of the original run club participants have gone on to join their middle school and high school cross country teams, carrying the passion for running that was ignited in 6th grade.

As the program continues to grow—from 25 students in its first year to 40 this past season—Gabrielson and Sieck remain energized by the impact they are making.

"Watching the students discover what they're capable of, whether it's a new personal best or just pushing through that first long run, is incredibly rewarding," said Sieck. "The 6th Grade Run Club is giving these students opportunities that will pay dividends for years to come."







## Hornet Central

### An Early Arrival Option for Middle Schoolers

#### At South View and Valley View Middle Schools for Grades 6-8

A partnership between Edina Community Ed, middle school building administration, and the Edina Public Schools Student Support Services department, Hornet Central provides an early arrival option for students and their families. Opportunities for service projects, student development, career exploration, and more will also be available throughout the school year.

- All students must be registered in order to arrive early to school and participate in Hornet Central.
- Doors open at 8 am. Transportation is not provided for this program.
- Students will be dismissed from Hornet Central at 9 am, allowing ample time for the 9:20 am school start time.
- For one monthly fee, students may attend any day that the program is in session.
- Hornet Central is open every day school is in session. The program is not offered on late start and no school days.

#### Monthly Program Costs:

## Community Service Letter Program

Edina High School students entering grades 9-12 can earn a letter in Community Service. Students can earn a letter by making a difference by serving their community and others.

Here are the steps required to earn a Community Service Letter:

1. Join the Community Service Letter Schoology page
2. Attend an in-person orientation (October)
3. Complete an application (due mid-December)
4. Complete 120 hours of service with at least 60 hours addressing a specific social issue. Hours must be completed by early April 2025 (deadline TBA)
5. By the April deadline, students will submit the following materials on Schoology:
  - Hours log demonstrating 120 hours of service
  - One letter of recommendation from a supervisor with an organization you volunteered with
  - Create a Creative Reflection artifact that represents your service work
6. Share your creative artifact and service experiences in a reflection session with your peers (April/May 2025).

# Early Childhood Family Education

Our hallmark program for infants, toddlers, and their parents is called “Early Childhood Family Education” or “ECFE.” Unique to Minnesota and supported by the legislature, ECFE has been supporting and strengthening families since 1973.

Here’s a preview of what you and your child will experience in ECFE:

### Parent-Child Activity Time

You and your child enjoy time together with developmentally appropriate activities, while connecting with other caregivers and educators.

### Parent Discussion

Join other caregivers and a Licensed Parent Educator to discuss the joys and challenges of parenting while learning effective, up-to-date, research-based parenting strategies.

### Children’s Learning Time

In classes where children and parents separate for the parent discussion, children will stay with licensed early childhood teachers. Children develop social-emotional skills while playing and learning with others.

### Sibling Care

Sibling care is available for children ages 6 weeks through pre-K while you attend an ECFE class. Sibling care is offered for all ECFE classes, Monday through Friday, 8:30am through 3:30pm. Register for sibling care when you register for your family education class.



### Sliding Fee Scale

For classes with a parent education (ECFE) component, tuition is charged on a sliding fee scale based on family household income. The price shown in the catalog is the most a family will pay.

### Age Specifications

Keep in mind to explore classes based on your child’s age as of 9/1/2024.

### Peanut Butter Cinnamon Yogurt Dip

#### INGREDIENTS:

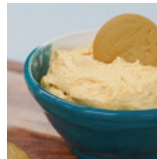
**Peanut Butter**

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Add a large scoop of plain yogurt in a bowl (we recommend using Stoneyfields organic plain or vanilla yogurt instead of Greek).
2. Add a large scoop of peanut butter. Any other creamy nut butter will work; try almond or cashew butter. Also, you may also use crunchy peanut butter.
3. Stir together
4. Add the desired amount of cinnamon and stir until acquired taste. Use any sweetener to sweeten the dip, like honey or maple syrup. You may also use agave.
5. Add a dash of cinnamon on top or additional optional toppings: crushed roasted peanuts, dark chocolate chips, or a bit of cinnamon.
6. Store in a tightly sealed container and place in the fridge for up to 5 days. We do not recommend freezing this yogurt dip unless you plan to enjoy it as ice cream!

## The Community of Women's Woodworking

**T**he Edina Community Ed woodshop is a well-established community that invites opportunities to work with a robust variety of tools along with direction and support through an advisory board.

Those opportunities include open woodshop, an orientation to the space, and one-off classes in skills such as marquetry.

The women's woodworking class is a dedicated, special group of students, all eager to learn the craft and find a creative outlet. For many, like Kelly, the class offered a chance to get reacquainted with power tools in a supportive, all-female environment.

"It's just so much easier when everyone is on the same playing field," Kelly explained. "I love being able to see what the other women are working on—everyone is so impressive!"

For Sophie, the class was a lifelong dream finally realized. "I used to walk by the woodshop all the time when my kids were in school and would smell the wood and would just dream of trying it myself," she recalled. When she finally took the plunge a few years ago, she was hooked.

"The instructors are so kind and helpful—they've really helped me tackle projects that I thought were way beyond my skill level," Sophie said. "And the other women are always there to lend a hand or share advice. It's such a supportive environment."

Participant Rachel was grateful for that supportive atmosphere as she tackled her first major woodworking project—an indoor bench. "I had never used a power tool before, but the teachers walked me through everything step-by-step. I'm so proud of what I was able to make." Since the bench project, Rachel has made numerous projects



including steps for her porch, a compost sifter, and a large frame for art in her living room. She found this craft has become a nice escape and community to belong to.

For the instructor, seeing the students' excitement and progress was the best part. "I just get to step in and help them learn new skills or avoid mistakes I've made in the past," they said. "It's amazing to see all the incredible projects that come out of this woodshop group."

The Edina Community Ed woodshop is a valuable resource for the entire community. As the women packed up their tools at the end of another productive session, they couldn't help but feel grateful for this special space to explore their creativity and build community.

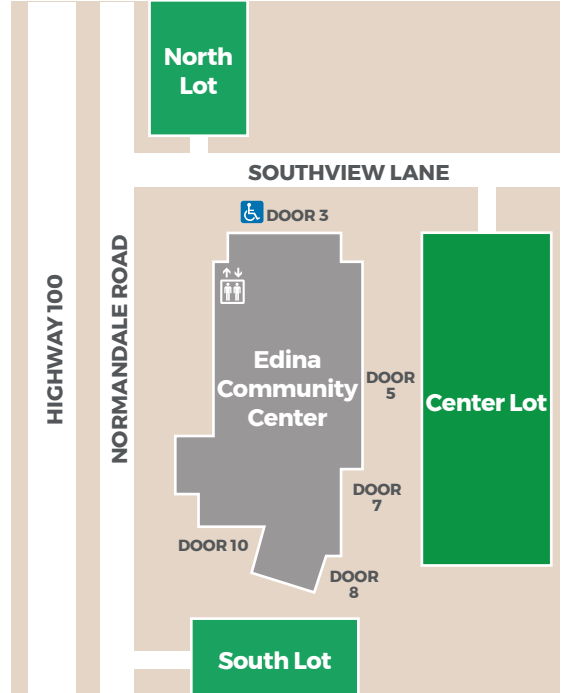
