

College Search

- Naviance
 - Click on “Colleges I am Thinking About”
 - On the left, click on SuperMatch
- Research
 - Once you have a list of schools from your search, look further into each school to see if it meets your needs
 - Visit schools (virtual is a good option)
- Prepare
 - Once you know what schools you are interested in applying to, be sure to look into the criteria for applying
 - Use [College Board](#) to look at test scores, classes, and GPA requirements for each school
 - This can help determine what classes to take senior year, if you need to increase your SAT or ACT score, and if the school is one to which you are likely to be accepted.
 - This can also help determine if you should add other schools to your list that are more in reach



Testing

- If you plan to apply to a 4-year school, take the SAT and/or ACT
 - You must register and pay for these tests on your own
 - SAT
 - www.collegeboard.org
 - March 13, May 8, June 5
 - ACT
 - www.act.org
 - April 17, June 12, July 17

Letters of Recommendation

- If applying to 4-year schools, you will need letters of recommendations written by teachers who know you well
- Ask 3 teachers to write letters
 - Ask in-person or via email
 - Once they say yes, add them to Naviance
 - At the top of Naviance, click on “Colleges”
 - Then click “Apply to College”
 - Then click “Teacher Recommendations” and add teachers
- Ask teachers before the end of the year
