COMMUNITY: New Egypt is located in Plumsted Township, the geographic center of New Jersey. Located in Ocean County, New Egypt is approximately one hour from both New York and Philadelphia. Once a small and rural town, New Egypt now represents the old and new, equally, as suburban sprawl has changed the community. Its forty-two square miles have been carefully developed to keep the agrarian flavor.

NEHS GRADING SYSTEM

GRADING SYSTEM: Student achievement is reported numerically. NEHS courses are used to calculate cumulative weighted and unweighted GPA's, excluding summer school courses. Using the appropriate multiplier, cumulative weighted averages are computed at the end of each school year, and in addition mid-year Junior year.

At New Egypt High School subjects are weighted. Students taking Honors classes receive an additional five (5) points to their final grade. Students taking Advanced Placement courses receive an additional ten (10) points to their final grade. This is reflected in students weighted grade point average (GPA).

CLASS RANK: New Egypt High School prefers not to rank its students. Ranking can prove to be misleading and not benefit the individual student. Rank is reported by decile for all NEHS students based on a cumulative grade point average of final grades of subjects completed in grades 9, 10, and 11

NEHS ACADEMIES: New Egypt High School proudly offers four competitive academies to our students. Students can apply to an academy in their 8th and 9th grade year. These academies are highly selective and require an application process. New Egypt High School offers an Engineering Academy, Business Academy, Law & Justice Academy, and Global Education Academy.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS: To graduate from New Egypt High School, students must accumulate 130 credits based on coursework completed in grades 9-12. This includes the successful completion of 20 credits of English, 20 credits of Physical Education and Health, 15 credits of Mathematics, 15 credits of Science, 15 credits of Social Studies, which includes two years of United States History and one year World History, 5 credits of World Language, 5 credits of Fine/Performing Arts, 2.5 credits of Personal Finance/Economics, 5 credits of Business/Practical Arts, 5 credits of College & Career Readiness, 22.5 credits of elective courses.

NEHS SCHEDULE: New Egypt High School operates on a 4x4 Block Schedule. Class Periods are 80 minutes in length. Students also have a 40 minute Flex period. Flex period is designed to allow students to meet with teachers for additional academic assistance, provide students with dedicated club/extracurricular time, and student study hall.
