Vice Chairman Gary Magnuson called the meeting to order at 6:00pm

3. Lighting Project

Tom M. provided an update: Pinney field is fully commissioned. Tedford East is fully commissioned. Lights are push button control. Will stay on for one hour – at 55 minutes a strobe light will flash to remind people that the time is almost up

Tedford West – Eversource had some storm responsibilities so they did not make the 15th for transformer installation – no new date as of yet

High school – transformer did get installed. All poles complete – wiring of poles started yesterday

PR discussions ongoing with Earthlight and ad hoc committee for "soft release" for early to mid august via FB with drone footage – will keep PBC updated as more information becomes available

Stephanie Gras: DRA has reviewed the bids and quotes submitted on July 10th, 2024.

After our review we recommend that the following be rejected and price quotes for these items be resolicited:

- Section 106 in its entirety
- Item #s CSD-5/5a/5b/5c, CSD-18, and CSD-31 from Section 201,
- Section 202 in its entirety
- Item #s M12, M14, and OT-4 through OT-20 inclusive, and Items U4 and U5 from Section 203.

We recommend that bids and quotes received for Technology Systems and Equipment that have not been recommended for award be held for further review.

Greg noted that there were some vastly different prices in OT equipment. Knows we can do better by putting these back out to bid

Gary Magnuson – how does rejection of these items affect the start of school and the turnover in December?

Stephanie - These items do not affect this section of phasing of the project. No indication there will be any impact to receiving these items in a timely manner

Stephanie – this was a very difficult package with tech and FF&E together. DRA has been doing great with trying to untangle and separate the packages and get everyone back on track
