RE: Identification of Students with Disabilities

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires that public school districts inform and provide certain information to the representatives of children attending non-public schools, including homeschools. Federal and state laws require school districts to conduct activities to locate, identify and evaluate all children with disabilities who are located within the geographic boundaries of the district. These activities are referred to as the "Child Find" process. The Child Find requirement applies to all children with disabilities including children who attend non-public and homeschools.
