

Morristown Beard School recognizes that our tuition cost represents a significant investment for a family in their student's future. We are committed to transparency for families as it pertains to our tuition, cost, and fee structures, as well as in our need-based financial aid program. The estimated cost of attendance for Morristown Beard School student is comprised of both required and optional costs. Your actual costs could differ depending on your student's choices in athletics, arts, travel opportunities, and more.

These fees are subject to change year over year, and should be used as a budget estimate. Enrolled families will be alerted to tuition and cost changes when applicable.

Tuition includes the core academic instruction for one school year, as well as lunch and many extracurricular costs. Tuition increases on a yearly basis, generally between 3-6%.
