*Beginning the week of **September 17<sup>th</sup>** students at **Eugene Auer, Hawkins Path, Holbrook Rd., Jericho, New Lane, N. Coleman Rd., Oxhead Rd, and Stagecoach Elementary Schools** will have access to a free fruit or vegetable twice weekly on select days. This program is not intended to replace the fruit and vegetable choices served in the cafeteria.*

***FFVP** is a federally assisted program providing free fresh fruits and vegetables to children at eligible elementary schools during the school day. The goal of the FFVP is to introduce children to fresh fruits and vegetables, to include new and different varieties, and to increase overall acceptance and consumption of fresh, unprocessed produce among children.*
