SCHOOL SUPPLIES NEEDED



Please bring these items on the FIRST DAY of school.



Label and send into school, some supplies will be shared.

- ★ Backpack (large enough to fit a folder, lunch bag, snack, and Chromebook when needed) (LABELED)
- ★ Lunch bag for lunch (LABELED "LUNCH")
- ★ Small bag for snack time food (LABELED "SNACK")
- ★ Two plastic pocket folders (LABELED)
- ★ One hard plastic pencil box to hold supplies (approx. 8 ½ x 5 ½ in.) (LABELED)

IN YOUR SUPPLY BOX YOU SHOULD HAVE...

(please put in your child's supply box for the first day)

- ★ 2 sharpened pencils
- ★ One box of 24 Crayola crayons (LABEL BOX WITH CHILD'S NAME)
- ★ One pair scissors (blunt edge, LABELED and <u>out of package</u>)
- ★ One glue stick (fat ones work the best and last longer)
- ★ One THIN YELLOW highlighter
- ★ One large pink eraser

Within the first two weeks, please send in the remainder of the supplies listed below, in a Ziploc Bag, labeled with your child's name.

- ★ A pair of LABELED CHILD sized, wired headphones to use with their Chromebook. PLEASE try them on your child to be sure they fit comfortably on your child's head. It is not necessary to spend a lot of money on this.
- ★ One pack (usually 4 or 6) of THIN DRY ERASE MARKERS.
- ★ One package/box of sharpened pencils (usually 12 or 18)
- ★ One hardcover, marbled notebook (LABELED)
- ★ One additional pink eraser
- ★ One box of colored pencils (LABEL BOX)
- ★ Two additional boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (LABEL BOX)
- ★ One package Crayola BROAD LINE markers (LABEL BOX)
- ★ Elmer's glue sticks (usually 6)
- ★ Two additional THIN YELLOW highlighters
- ★ One 4 pack Playdough
- ★ Please do not send your child to school with a small pencil sharpener. It is a safety issue.

Other Important Information

- Our class symbol is a ladybug! Make sure your child wears the ladybug tag to school everyday for the first two weeks of school.
- If your child is absent from school a note <u>MUST</u> accompany your child upon their return to school with the date and the reason for absence clearly stated.
- If you are picking your child up early, please send in a note on the day you'll be picking
 your child up early with a time. YOU MUST SHOW PHOTO ID.
- A snack time will be reserved each day. Please send in a nutritious snack and drink (i.e. fruit, crackers, cheese, vegetable sticks). Please no candy or soda.
- Please make sure that your child knows in advance if they are buying lunch and what
 they are buying. It is also very helpful for your child to have their snack items separate
 from their lunch items. Please discuss with your child what is for snack and what is for
 lunch prior to school each day. Thank you!
- Please send in a ziplock bag with a change of clothes for your child. We will keep the
 clothes in the classroom for any accidents or spills that will happen. I will send the
 clothing bags home before the December break and again before the April break for a
 season and size clothes swap.
- Chromebooks are not needed for the first few weeks of school, I will let you know when to start sending them into school.
