The Potato Hug provides you with a venue to display your FFA Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) projects. Your project is an opportunity for you to demonstrate professionalism, develop entrepreneurial skills, and showcase your hard work.

Advantages of participating in the Potato Hug:

- Complete Your SAE Early!
- Receive Presentation Credit
- Earn your own money
- The Potato Hug brings in approx. 200 - 300 people each year.
- There are local businesses that will be selling items alongside you. This is a wonderful way for you to learn from real life experiences.
- The only cost to you for participating in the Potato Hug is the \$5.00 student vendor fee. Students must cover any cost with their project.

Potato Hug SAE Requirements

All students must arrive at the Potato Hug no later than 9:30 a.m. and stay until 2:00 p.m. If students sell out they must remain at their table until 2:00 p.m. All projects must include:
