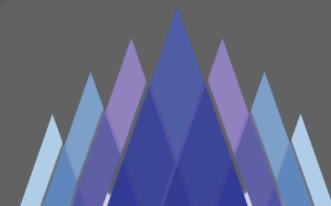

WHAT IS AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE?

Advisory Committees are comprised of teachers, students, community members, business leaders, and industry professionals who assist educators in establishing, operating, and evaluating CTE programs.

Committees are needed to:

- Provide an opportunity for discussion among people in education, business, and industry.
- Focus on how to improve CTE and make the most of community partnerships.
- Provide expertise to the program by reviewing curriculum, facilities, student competencies, and student placement in related occupations.



HOW CAN I CHAMPION CTE?

As an advisory committee member, you will have the opportunity to positively impact the next generation by:

- Ensuring a skilled and sustainable workforce.
- Connect educators with internship and work-based learning opportunities.
- Ensure the knowledge and skills taught are aligned with workforce needs.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

WHEN ARE THE MEETINGS?

- Attend a minimum of two meetings per year.
