Thank you in advance for purchasing these supplies for your child. Please send these supplies to school with your child on the first day. Also, please <u>label your child's supplies with their first and last name</u>, and <u>place them in 1 large bag also clearly labeled with your child's name</u>. If you cannot get all of the items before the first day of school, we ask that you send them in no later than Monday, September 9th.

1	backpack (large enough to hold a lunch box, binder, and a folder – no wheels please!)	
1	plastic bottom-pocket folder (Please pick up the plastic-type folder. They are tear-resistant, waterproof and durable enough to last the whole year. This folder will be used as our Home/School Folder.)	
1	1½ inch hard covered 3 ring binder (We suggest the One Touch EZ D-ring binders. They are very easy for children to open.)	
1	Primary journal - Pages should have a <u>blank space at the top for a picture</u> and primary writing lines on the bottom half of the page.	
3	yellow highlighters	
1	package of sharpened yellow pencils (approx. 10 - for everyday use)	
2	large white erasers	
3	packages of Crayola crayons, 24 count, regular colors (1 pack for each trimester)	
2	10 count packages of Crayola washable markers (fat, broad-tipped kind)	
6	large (fat) glue sticks (fat ones last longer)	
1	pair of blunt-tipped, child-size scissors	
4	black THIN Expo dry-erase markers (the THIN ones are easiest for little hands to hold)	
4	containers of Play-doh (any color, labeled)	
1	Pair of child size, wired headphones (Please no ear buds or wireless, bluetooth headphones)	
1	Package of baby wipes	
1	Extra set of clothing in a Zip-Loc bag to be stored in the classroom (please label)	
2	Lunch bags (1 small bag for snack, 1 larger bag for lunch)	
1	Small, <u>leak-proof</u> water bottle filled with <u>water only</u>	

Schedule for Sending Supplies into School

Wednesday, Sept. 4th

- Plastic supply box filled with one pack of crayons, 1 white eraser, 1 highlighter, 1 glue stick, 5 sharpened pencils, and a pair of scissors. Please label the supply box and all supplies with your child's name (individual pencils and crayons do not have to be labeled).
- Plastic bottom-pocket folder
- Back to school paperwork: First Day Note (see below), Emergency contact card, Tell Us About Your Child, etc.
- Snack & Lunch (if not buying lunch)
- Small, leak-proof water bottle
- Extra set of clothing

Thursday, Sept. 5th

- Primary journal
- 1½ inch hard binder
- Child-sized, wired headphones

Friday, Sept. 6th

- Large Zip-loc bag with the rest of the supplies, labeled with your child's name
- Baby wipes (1 package)

Other Important Information

- Absent notes should accompany your child upon his/her return to school with the date and the reason for absence clearly stated.
- Photo ID is required to enter the building <u>at all times</u>.
- For early dismissals, please send in a note on the day you will be picking your child up early or call the main office.
- A snack time will be reserved each day. Please send in a nutritious snack and drink. Please no candy or soda.
- Please make sure that your child knows in advance if they are buying lunch and what they are buying. It is also very helpful for your child to have their snack items separate from their lunch items. It may be helpful for your child if you label the bag with the word "snack" and a symbol such as a smiley face or star. Please discuss with your child what is for snack and what is for lunch prior to school each day.
- If you apply for free lunch and are approved, please let us know.
