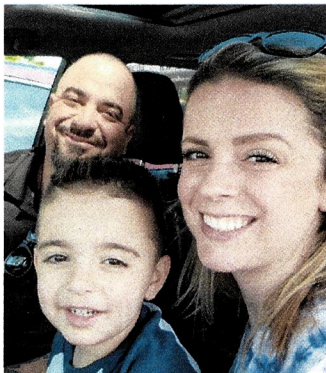

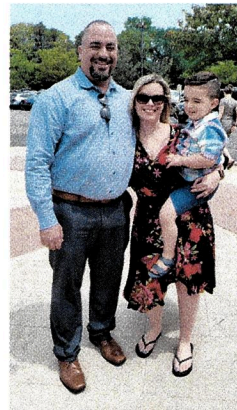

_____ 1-inch hard binder with a pocket on the front

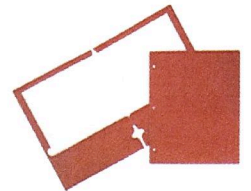
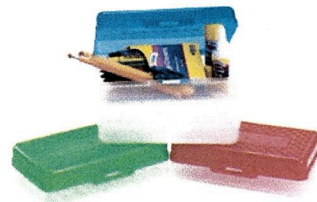
