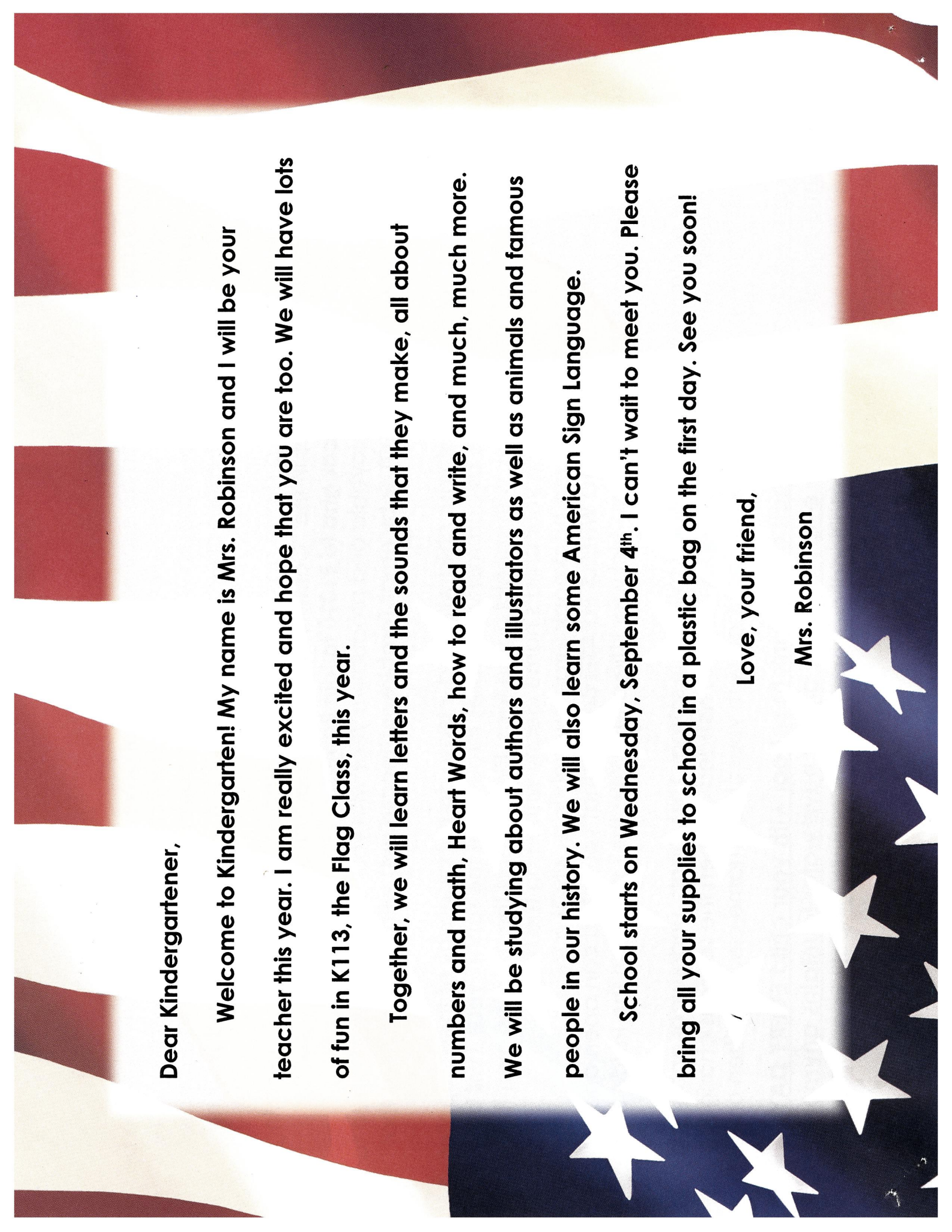

Enclosed is a list of supplies that your child will need. Please **do not** label any of these supplies individually. We will be sharing them as community supplies throughout the school year. I will be labeling the folder and the notebook with special name tags. Please send the supplies in on the first day of school in a plastic bag with your child's name clearly written on the bag.

Your child will also need a **zippered backpack** large enough to easily fit a folder, Chromebook, lunchbox and jacket. **NO WHEELS PLEASE!** Be sure that your child can open and close it by themselves. Some fasteners are tricky for little ones. Write their name on the **inside** of the backpack.

A change of clothes will also be needed to keep in school. Shirt, pants, underwear and socks should be included. These will need to be replenished as needed or when the seasons change. Please label all clothing and place it in a zip-lock bag with your child's name clearly written on it.

Please send a small, healthy snack and a drink to school with your child EVERY DAY. Also, send in a refillable water bottle every day. We do not have water fountains anymore.

You may also want to purchase additional crayons, markers, pencils, glue sticks and scissors to set up a special “Homework Helper Kit” for home.
