Students may use backpacks and can request a locker if they choose.


Freshman Orientation for Students

## What do I need to participate?

#### Valid physical on file with the school nurse

- The school district physician conducts examinations in August before the following school year and prior to the start of each season.
- If the student/family wishes to provide their own physical they may do so but having the doctor complete the districts athletic physical form.

• Both the student and parents must complete the required forms and sign-offs.

#### **Academics**

- Student Athlete NOT Athlete Student
- 1 failing course is probation and 2 is an appeal

## **Community Service**

- Community service will be noted on the transcript after 25 hours or more of recognized service per year.
- Recognition will be awarded for summer volunteer work. (After July 1 it will be noted under the next school year).
- Seniors completing the community service credit will be recognized at graduation after meeting the 100 hour requirement.
- The community service booklet can be found online under the Guidance tab on the district website and it is updated yearly.
