- Train and support students and teachers on the ongoing integration of technology in high-quality instruction.

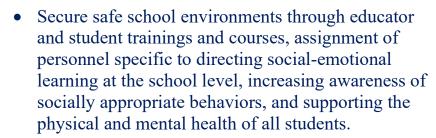


- Develop an environment of mastery through the implementation of high-quality curricula and interventions to ensure that students are prepared for learning in the next grade level.

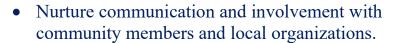
Student Safety, Health, and Well-Being
