



### **Sweeny ISD Charge Procedures**

Parents and guardians have multiple options to deposit money into their students' accounts. They can bring cash or checks directly to the cafeteria or to the Child Nutrition Office located at the Transportation Building. Students can also deposit money into their accounts while in the cafeteria line. Additionally, parents can use a credit or debit card to deposit money online and monitor the account status through MySchoolCafe at [www.schoolcafe.com/sweenyisd](http://www.schoolcafe.com/sweenyisd).

District charge policy states that despite a negative balance, students are still allowed to charge breakfast and lunch to their accounts and will receive a complete meal. However, they cannot charge a la carte items if their account balance is negative.

The Child Nutrition Office will send negative balance alerts via Mail, phone call, and email if one is available. These notifications will continue on a weekly basis until the balance is settled. Both the Child Nutrition Office and Campus Administration will make ongoing efforts to collect any outstanding balances.

This procedure is uniformly applied across all campuses within the Sweeny Independent School District.
