Sneak Peek

We can't wait to see all of our students at our annual Sneak Peek on **Thursday, August 1.** To assist with volume, students with last names A-L should attend from 8:30-9:30 a.m. and M-Z from 9:30-10:30 a.m. Teachers will be sending a welcome email by 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 31 to introduce themselves. Should you not be able to attend Sneak Peek, we ask that you please reply to the teacher and ensure they know how your child should be dismissed on the first day of school (i.e., car rider, bus #, daycare, etc.) We highly encourage that students begin their normal dismissal routines on the first day of school.



Parking is limited so please be patient and don't block anyone in and/or park in a fire lane!

Upon arrival, please visit our **cafeteria FIRST** to:

- Register as a car rider, if needed (If you already have a carpool number, please stop by and verify that number with the team.)
- Update cafeteria accounts (visit www.mypaymentsplus.com to sign up and prepay online for your child's account)
- Pick-up pre-purchased school supply kits (If you did not preorder your school supplies, please click [here](#) for our current school supply list.)

Once you have completed all of the items listed above, please visit your child's classroom to meet his/her teacher.

Attention ALL 2nd Grade Families

Fulton County Schools is requiring all families who are new to the district and/or those entering grades 2, 7 and 10 to submit two proofs of residency prior to the start of the school year. One of the approved utility items and one of the approved residency items must be provided. We ask that you please bring the original and a copy with you to sneak peek. We must see the original and then we will keep the copy to scan and upload to your child's permanent record. If proof of residency is not provided by the first day of school, your child will be placed on a provisional enrollment for 30 days. On the 31st day of enrollment, if proof of residency has still not been provided, your child will have to be withdrawn from school.

One Utility Item: Current water or electric monthly statement (Note: Gas bills are not accepted)

One Residency Item: Current mortgage bill/statement, Home sales contract, Current apartment/house lease, Section Eight/HUD housing document, Current HOA bill

Both documents must contain parent/guardian name and current address where the student resides.

First Day of School

- The first day of school is **Monday, August 5.** Our school hours are from 7:40 a.m. – 2:20 p.m. Arrival begins at 7:10 a.m. Parents may begin lining up in the carpool lane; however, for supervision reasons, students should not enter the building prior to 7:10 a.m.
- We encourage you to get your children into their normal routines, i.e., arrival/dismissal, as quickly as possible by having them come to and leave school the way they normally would come and go. Dismissal tends to run a little slow the first few days of school as we are triple checking to make sure all of our students get home the correct way. Please help your child learn his/her dismissal routine by remembering their carpool number (you will get this number at Sneak Peek if you do not already have one) and/or bus number.
- We will not be accepting lunch visitors until after Labor Day so we can help the students get into their normal lunch routines. Please feel free to begin visiting for lunch during your child's regular lunch time the week of **September 2.**

- Download the Here Comes the Bus app or visit www.herecomesthebus.com
- Click the **Sign Up** button
- Enter school code **87428**
- Click “Next” followed by “Confirm”
- Complete the “User Profile” box
- Under “My Students,” click “Add.” Enter your child’s last name and student ID number.
- Once you confirm your information, you’re ready to go!



If your child is being dropped off in the carpool line, please be mindful of the traffic, and allow plenty of time. Carpool students that are not in the building when the bell rings at 7:40 will be counted as tardy. As a reminder, if your child is riding the bus in the morning, and the bus is late, he/she will never be counted tardy.
