

DREHER HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING AGREEMENT 2024-2025

- To purchase a parking permit, you must have completed the Alive @ 25 defensive driving class.
- Parking on campus is a privilege, not a right.
- All vehicles parked on school property are subject to search.
- The parking permit must be placed in the REARVIEW MIRROR!
- By receiving a parking permit, you agree to abide by the rules and regulations.

The following are prohibited:

- 1. Speeding (Speed Limit is 10 mph).
- 2. Reckless Driving.
- 3. Loitering/Social Gathering.
- 4. Failure to obey traffic control directions.
- 5. Returning to the parking lot during school hours without approval from a DHS Administrator. (Exceptions: Heyward).
- 6. Leaving campus without signing out and a Dismissal Slip on hand.
- 7. Loud music.
- 8. Littering.

Violations of parking lot rules may result in loss of parking privilege.

Parking privilege will be revoked if the following Richland County School District One Code violations occur:

3 Level I violations, 2 Level II violations, 1 Level III violation
