Parking Permit Rules and Disclaimer Notice-2024-2025**

- 1) **All rules of the road apply to all school parking lot areas.** Motor vehicles are not to be driven over 5 miles per hour on all school property.
- 2) **Students MUST complete the Parking Lot Safety Course with Officer Ballow to be eligible for a parking tag.**
- 3) **DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE IN AREAS WHERE BUSES ARE LOADING OR UNLOADING.** State law prohibits driving your vehicle in these areas. You are subject to a court summons and a heavy fine if reported to law enforcement agencies.
- 4) **Students are to park in the student parking lot only.** Do not park in handicap, 15-minute parking, crosswalks, faculty and staff spots. Parking is not allowed along the access road.
- 5) **Students are NOT to go into cars at ANY time during the school day** or use their vehicle to leave school property without prior permission and a pass from the rear attendance office and/or the Assistant Principal’s office.
- 6) **Parking Permit MUST be hung from rear view mirror while parking on campus.** Vehicles without a valid Permit will be subject to Warning Violation Stickers.
- 7) There will be a \$5 fee to replace a lost parking tag. Parking tags are not transferable or to be shared with another student.

STUDENT PARKING IS RESERVED FOR JUNIOR AND SENIOR CLASS STUDENTS ONLY!

****CHS reserves the right to ticket any cars who do not follow the parking regulations. CHS reserves the right to revoke or temporarily suspend parking privileges due to behavior infractions or other violations of the Student Code of Conduct or if parking rules are violated. Your fee will NOT BE REFUNDED. ****

Please note: By issuance of a permit, the Clarence Central District and/or Clarence High School does not assume liability for any property damage to any private automobile parked on its property. The owner-operator(s) of all private vehicles accepts responsibility for their own property and agrees they are parking at their own risk. The owner of the vehicle assumes the responsibility of all parking violations that are issued and any removal of violation stickers thereof. Vehicles must always be operated in a safe and legal manner on school grounds. Any vehicle blocking fire lanes, emergency exits, delivery areas, bus, handicap parking, etc., will be towed and/or driver fined and parking privileges removed Clarence Central School District assumes no responsibility for any article left in any car or for any damage which may be caused to any car or part thereof. Snowmobiles, ATV's and unlicensed dirt bikes are not allowed on school property.
