CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT AGRICULTURE

This 2-hour lesson will introduce controlled environment agriculture (CEA) in the forms of hydroponics, aquaculture, and aquaponics. Scouts will be involved in hands-on learning through an exercise involving seeding and transplanting and will get a tour of the Research Greenhouse where they will learn about some of the applications of these CEA-technologies to positively impact food security. Learning will occur via discussions throughout the interaction.
