



Inclement Weather Policy

For most weather-related situations, the Warren H. Daugherty Aquatic Center will follow South Lane School District's delay and closure policies. The following will address the most common occurrences but is not an exhaustive list.

In the event of an inclement weather School **delay**, the Pool will follow South Lane in opening at 10:00am unless otherwise specified.

In the event of inclement weather School **closure**, the Pool will automatically close until 12:00pm and further notice will be given for the rest of the business day.

The Pool schedule will continue unaltered upon reopening. Swim lesson or other pre-paid event cancellations will be address individually, other programs will not be made up or rescheduled.

Notification will be sent out to members via multiple channels including our website, Facebook page, and email list. In the event of a multiple day closure the Pool's voicemail system will also reflect current updates.

Ice/Snow Conditions

Delays and closures are typically made between 5:30 – 6:30am. South Lane School's use Flash Alert. Members may sign up for this service to receive the earliest notifications.

Air Quality

Staff use the Lane Regional Air Protection Agency and Purple Air to monitor air quality. Closure will occur at any point South Lane Schools close or air quality reaches the Very Unhealthy level (200) for longer than 60 minutes. Upon air quality closure, the facility will not reopen until air quality is lower than Unhealthy (150).

Thunder & Lightning

The facility will close down for 30 minutes from every site or sound in the event of a thunder and lightening storm. During this time the pools will be cleared immediately and the public will be asked to vacate the facility. The Pool deck and locker rooms will remain off limits until the facility reopens.

Power Outages

In the event of a power outage the pools will be evacuated immediately. The facility will remain closed until power has returned and our mechanical system is back in working order.

Extreme Heat

During a heat advisory the Therapy pool may be closed to lower the risk of heat related injuries.
