LDYBA League for Boys grades 3 to 6

The goal and vision of the Lower Dauphin Youth Basketball Association (LDYBA) is to provide a district wide developmental basketball program for boys in grades K through 6. The program will teach skills and fundamentals in a positive, fun and educational environment.

<u>For grades 3 to 6</u> there will be multiple weekly practices and/or games using PIAA officials at the elementary schools and the LD Middle School in the evening at times that are "age appropriate" or on a Saturday. The program will run from November 2017 to February 2018. All attempts will be made to geographically split the boys into teams to minimize drive time. (more details are on the website)

After School program for Boys grades K-2 starting in January

For grades K to 2 there will be a after school program at the elementary schools starting in January 2018. The program will be 1 day per week over 6 weeks with a time slot of 3:40 pm to 4:45 pm. There will also be 1 Saturday practice and Half Time Show at a varsity game. This program is about skill building and teaching fundamentals. Advanced 2nd grade boys can tryout for the weekly 3rd-4th grade league. PLEASE NOTE: Although K-2 starts in January, IT FILLS UP QUICKLY - SIGN UP TODAY!

TRAVEL TEAM TRYOUTS

The LDYBA will be forming a 4th, 5th and a 6th grade competitive travel team. The 4th grade team will also play in the LDYBA League. The teams will be LD boys only. These teams are for advanced players and will have a more competitive structure. The 5th & 6th grade teams will practice 3 nights per week and play in a Saturday league. A basketball comes first and 100% commitment during the months of November through February is expected from the boys selected. To tryout you must register online and check the "YES" box for travel tryouts. Tryouts are 10/16 and 10/18 at Conewago Elementary - 4th/5th @ 6-7:15 and 6th @ 7:15-8:30 Players not selected will play in the LDYBA league.

Participation Fee

For K-6 there will be a small participation fee of \$60 per player to help offset the cost of basketballs, blue/ white numbered reversible jerseys that players keep, PIAA game officials, first aid kits, practice equipment, and season ending team activities. Scholarships: Travel Teams cost are separate and additional.
