

INFORMATION ON 2024 LEVIES

These levies are NOT a new tax. These levies renew expiring taxes that provide local funding for needs not covered by state and federal funding. They are the second largest revenue source for the South Whidbey School District, making up about 16% of the budgeted general fund.



Details

- Vote by November 5, 2024
- Approval of this levy will not change the current tax rate.
- Local education levies support learning, safety and healthy schools
- Exemptions for seniors/disabled

Two Propositions:

- · Replacement Levy for Capital Improvements Including Facilities, Technology and Safety Resolution 687 -for six years commencing in 2025 for collection in the years from 2026 though 2031
- Replacement Levy for Educational Programs and Operations Resolution 686 - for three years commencing in 2025 for collection in the years 2026, 2027 and 2028.

2024 levy propositions replace expiring levies to support the District's educational, operations, facilities, technology and safety programs. They help maintain class size, improve student achievement, support programs and services, and fund the extra costs associated with food service, special education, band, athletics, 1:1 technology, and bus service that are not covered by the state.
