

Jennie Moore Elementary Student Dress Code

The JME student dress code will follow the CCSD Student Dress Code with a couple of additions for safety of elementary students.

Guidelines for Attire:

- Clothing is to be worn appropriately and in the manner for which it was designed.
- Pants shall be worn at waist level. Undergarments should not be exposed.
- Clothing shall not reveal bare skin between upper chest and mid-thigh.
- Shirts, sweatshirts, etc. should be at an appropriate length so as to not cover up the garments worn on the bottom.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses shall be of adequate length to assure modesty.
- Hats are not allowed in the building. Hoods on hoodies should not be worn indoors.
- Shoes must be worn —Backless shoes are not permitted; tennis shoes are to be worn on PE days.

Prohibited Attire:

- Clothing with words or images that depict or relate to tobacco, drugs, or alcohol.
- Clothing or other attire displaying profanity, obscenity, violence, weapons, symbols of hate or offensive content.
- Clothing that displays inflammatory, suggestive, racial, or other inappropriate writing, advertisement, or artwork.
- Leggings, jeggings, tights, or yoga pants worn without a shirt or top that reaches fingertip length.
- Loungewear, pajamas, and bedroom slippers
- No halters, backless, strapless, bare shoulder or spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.
