 - > Fall 2021-Grades 3-10
 - > 1 hour per content area
- Technology-based
- Measuring previous years learning of NJSLS

NJSLA

- > Two (2) day administration
 - Spring 2022 Grades3-8 and 11
 - > Total three (3) hours per content area
- > Technology based
- Measures current years learning of NJSLS
