St. Joseph's Academy is a Catholic, college-preparatory school for girls, serving grades 9-12. It was founded in 1868 by the Sisters of St. Joseph and is the oldest high school in Baton Rouge, the capital of Louisiana and home of Louisiana State University and Southern University.

One hundred percent of our students attend a college or university. SJA is a five-time National Blue Ribbon School awardee. SJA was honored by the U.S. Department of Education in 1991, 1996, 2002, 2016 and 2023. The faculty consists of professional educators, many of whom have advanced degrees. SJA is accredited by the Louisiana State Department of Education and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and is a member of the Southern Association for College Admission Counseling, the National Association for College Admission Counseling and the College Board. SJA complies with the NACAC Statement of Principles of Good Practice.

**Dual Enrollment** classes through Louisiana State University are offered in Calculus (Business Calculus or Differential/Integral), English IV (English Composition I & II), Individual Wellness & Public Health, Pre-Calculus (College Algebra/College Trigonometry), U.S. History (U.S. History to 1865/1865-present). Entry is determined by criteria set by LSU for GPA, ACT scores and prerequisite courses.

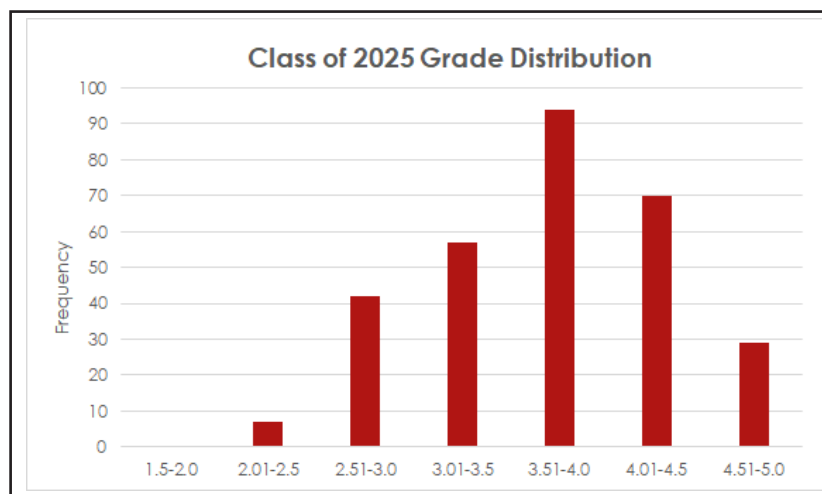
