### 2024-2025 School Meal Information...

Breakfast will cost \$1.50 for paying students and \$.30 for reduced price students.

An elementary lunch will cost \$3.25 and a secondary lunch is \$3.35.

Reduced price lunch for all grades is \$.40. Ala Carte items will be sold at an additional charge.



For lunch, students must take at least three of the five meal components (meat, grain, fruit, vegetable, and milk). In order for the meal to be considered a complete meal, one of these three components must be a fruit, juice, or vegetable.

We also serve breakfast! For breakfast, students must take at least three of the offered items, with one being a fruit, vegetable, or juice. For more information regarding what makes a meal, please see the link below.

Any second meals, second entrees, or ala carte items will be charged to the student's account.

Free and reduced meal applications will be processed to determine eligibility for meals. We encourage households who may qualify to apply with a meal application in order to receive these benefits. A new meal application must be submitted yearly, unless you received a letter in the mail stating that your household automatically qualified for free/reduced meals through the direct certification process.

- For the 2024-2025 school year, we are implementing a new procedure for volunteers. All new and existing volunteers will need to complete the Verkada application. This process

If your student is a district resident and not in a walk zone, please download the Stopfinder App on your phone. You will receive an email with a link to activate Stopfinder in the coming days.

Once you have access, you will be able to see all of your student's bus information. If you have any problems with the link or do not receive it, please email the transportation office at [danvilletransportation@danville.k12.in.us](mailto:danvilletransportation@danville.k12.in.us) and we will address that issue. **HepB:** The minimum age for the third dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

**DTaP:** Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if fourth dose was administered on or after the fourth birthday.

**Polio:** Three doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the fourth birthday and at least six months after the previous dose.

\*For students in grades K-12, the final dose must be administered on or after the fourth birthday and be administered at least six months after the previous dose.

**Varicella:** Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Parent report of disease history is not acceptable.

**Tdap:** There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

**MCV4:** Individuals who receive their first dose on or after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday only need one dose of MCV4.

**Hepatitis A:** The minimum interval between first and second dose is six calendar months. Two doses are required for all grade levels.

## • 2024-2025 School Calendar •

Wondering about our 2024-2025 school dates? Here you go!

This year we have four days blocked off for eLearning and Waiver of Instruction Days/Release Days granted by the Department of Education. The eLearning days will be eLearning BASIC days where students can complete their assigned work at their own pace, and teachers will have office hours available. Waiver or Instruction/Release days are no-work days for students. Teachers will be in all day, but they will not prepare any material for students.

The eLearning and Release days are as follows:

- September 10 - eLearning BASIC Day
- November 4 - Release Day
- February 26 - Release Day
- April 10 - TBD

The last day will be determined based on how many Release days and/or eLearning days we have left. We are only allotted a certain amount each year in order to fulfill the 180 school day requirements.
