Athletic Trainer

Qualifications:

1. Bachelor's degree required;
2. Hold or be eligible to hold a New Jersey School Athletic Trainer Certificate;
3. CPR Certified
3. Any other qualifications as set by State Certification Agency.

Reports To: Athletic Director

Supervises: Students as directed

Job Goal: To plan and manage the athletic healthcare program for students in accordance with state law/regulations and Board policy.

Performance Responsibilities:

1. Assess the physical well-being of the pupils in terms of developmental and present health status.
2. The athletic trainer will be able to demonstrate an ability to perform the following functions regarding athletic injuries: prevention, assessment, treatment, (including first aide) and reconditioning as set forth by the NATA Board of certification.
3. The athletic trainer will demonstrate proper taping, strapping, bracing, and fitting of athletic equipment.
4. The athletic trainer will carry out all prescribed treatments and recommendations by the team/program/event physician.
5. The athletic trainer will maintain NATA and CPR certification in accordance with those respective institutions.
6. The athletic trainer will cover assigned pre-season physicals, sports games or matches, and related events under the supervision of the program manager.
7. The athletic trainer must demonstrate knowledge of the principals of growth and development over the life span and possess the ability to assess data reflective of the athletes' status and interpret the appropriate information.
8. Must be able to assist with or transfer athletes of various weight/height.
9. Must be able to push carts with athletic equipment on them.
10. Must be able to stand for long periods of time, have good mobility skills and be able to walk long distances.
11. Must demonstrate ability to communicate to give adequate directions and instructions to subordinates.
12. Must be able to carry training kit and coolers for long distances.
13. Perform other duties which may be within the scope of his/her employment and certifications as may be assigned by his/her supervisor or other member of the administrative staff under the authority of the Board of Education.
14. Perform all other responsibilities and duties as may be assigned by the Superintendent of Schools and/or his/her designees.
