



Parents and Student Drivers:

Complete and return this form no later than 72 hours of needing parking privileges on school property. This form must be updated and resubmitted with any vehicle or insurance policy changes.

The following rules for driving and parking on school grounds:

- 1.** You must have a valid driver's license, proof of vehicle registration and proof of insurance. As per Colorado State Statute, these documents must be provided to Ellicott High School to be copied as part of the permanent record. Any changes to these documents must be submitted to Ellicott High School within a timely manner.
- 2.** Student drivers must observe the speed limit of 10 miles per hour while on any school property and posted speed limits when traveling between properties to include the "School Zone". Speeding or Careless Driving will be reported to local law enforcement.
- 3.** Student parking is on the north side of the high school, west of the large propane tank and is the only designated student parking area. Students are **not** permitted to park in any other area or parking lots on the school district property during school hours.
- 4.** Once your car is parked and you enter the building, the vehicles and parking lot are off limits until school is dismissed at the end of the day. If there is an emergency or you need to go to your car, you must have permission from the front office prior to going to your vehicle. You may not use your vehicle to travel between buildings.
- 5.** Any vehicle that you will be driving to school must be listed below. When on school property, your parking permit **must be clearly displayed** with the permit number clearly visible in the vehicle that you are driving. If you are ***temporarily***

(two days or less) driving a vehicle not listed below, please make sure to transfer your parking permit to that vehicle.

By signing this document, parents and student drivers agree to abide by the above rules. Failure to comply with the above rules can result in written warnings, parent contact, revocation of parking privileges, contact to law enforcement or a tow truck company. The privilege of bringing a student operated motor vehicle on the school property is consent for school officials to search the vehicle if there is reasonable suspicion that a search is necessary due to violations of school policy, suspected illegal activity or regarding discipline investigations. Student's failure to comply with conditions set forth by the school regarding the privilege to drive and park a motor vehicle on school property can be revoked at any time.
