The Junior Class has had a very busy and profitable year.



HISTORY OF THE CLASS OF 1965

It was on an unforgettable September morning that the Class of 1965 met for the first time under the supervision of Miss Mary Disparti and Mrs. Zana Dickens. 
The final production of the Class of 1965 was the Senior Ball, Christmas Holiday, held December 23 in our gymnasium. The Galen Stout Quartet played the music.
