its blinding light.


What shall we do

William Chester Fanton 1957-1974


In this small way we would like to show our lasting remembrance of William C. Fanton, a very special friend and classmate of the Class of '76.


Aside from his regular duties, he was the National Honor Society advisor and a bus driver.
