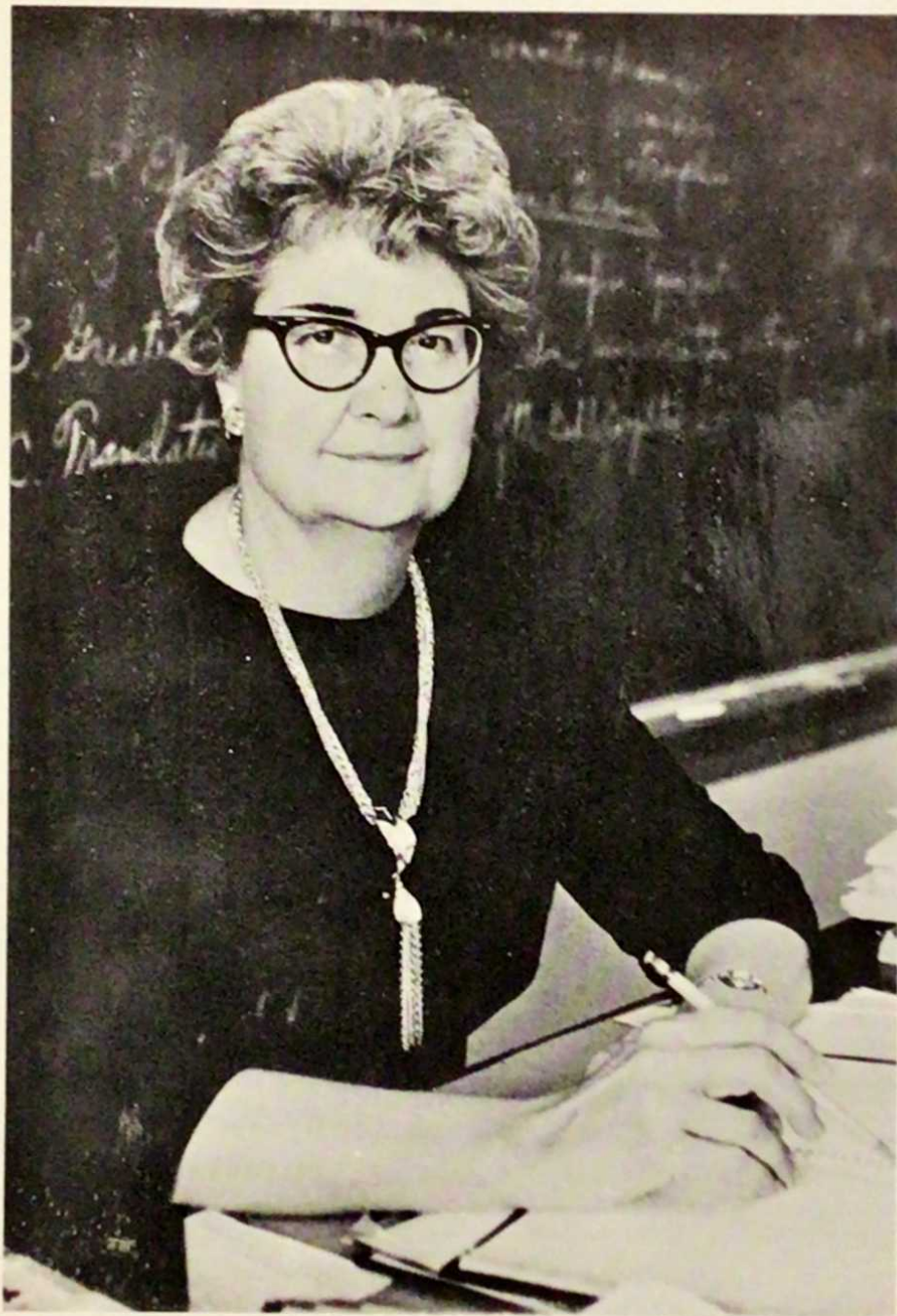

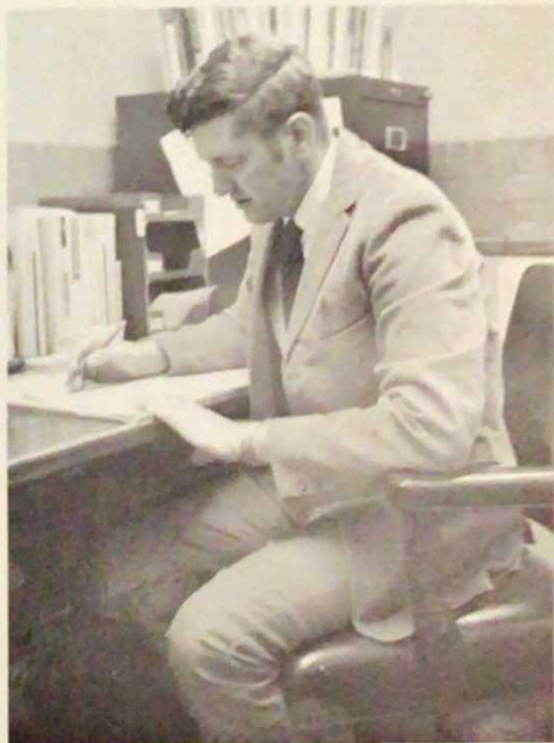


MISS RUTH ROSSNEY
