The next year found us moving on to the classes of Mrs. Mary Hosmer and Mrs. Virginia Horner, and also meeting two new fellow students, Brad Cooper and Cathy Smith. It was in first grade that we had our first encounter with the "classical" Dick and Jane books.

Second grade found us "enjoying" arithmetic under the direction of Mrs. Helen Steenrod and Mrs. Virjean Francis. Dave Austin joined us in time to present a gym demonstration for our parents and to help us make bread.

In April we presented our prom, "The Impossible Dream," with music by the Galen Stout Quartet. Despite a lack of cellophane tape and many doubts offered by Mr. Howbridge, we finished the decorations. On that perfect night, Diane Fuller and Bradley Cooper were crowned Queen and King. Their court included Joyce Kemp, Diane Miller, Shelley Grastorf, Steve Lowe, Bob Clark, and Dave Mitchell. We also managed to capture the most points in Field Day bringing more honors to the class of 1968.

As Seniors, we startled everyone with our salesmanship as we sold 150 percent of our quota of magazines, to raise money for our Senior Trip to Washington. Finally, the great day arrived and we boarded the bus along with Mr. and Mrs. Donald Strach and Mr. and Mrs. Galen Stout. We then had four days and nights of "peace," "enjoyment," and "relaxation." We returned home and began applying to colleges and preparing for our Senior dance in December.

Now as we 37 seniors look back over the years of our education at BCS, we can proudly say that we shall always remember the joys, sorrows, friendships, and experiences that we have known while together.
