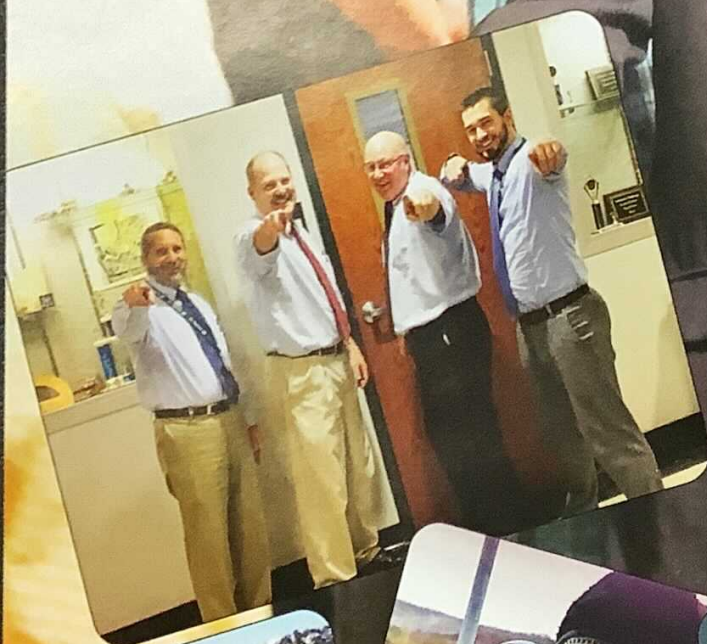
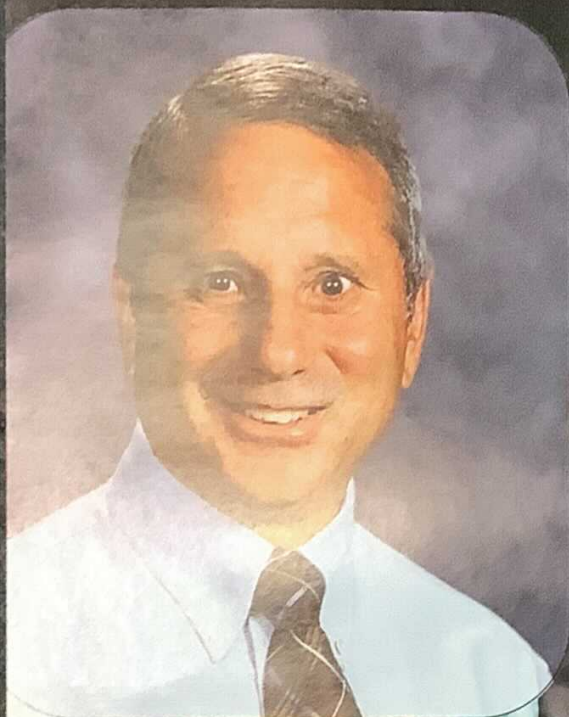

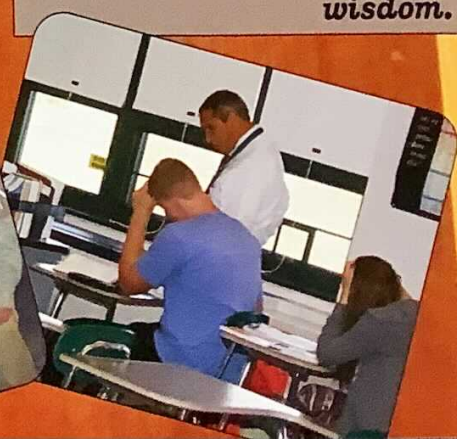

Mr. Paul Abdo

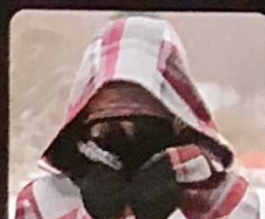

We thank you, Mr. Abdo, for your years of guidance and wisdom.



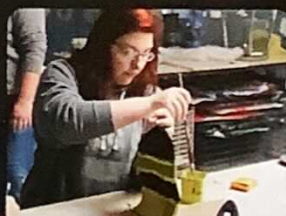

The students have been building and designing robots, obstacle courses and computer programs as part of the First Lego League challenges!



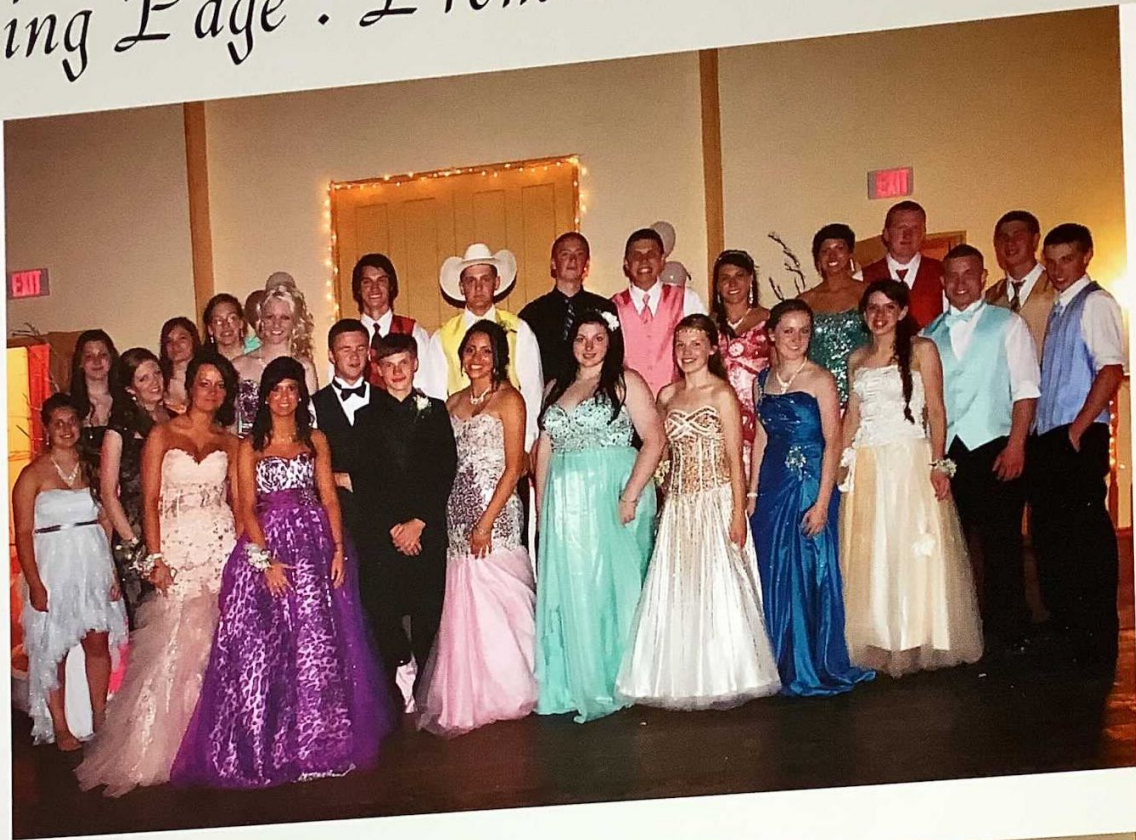

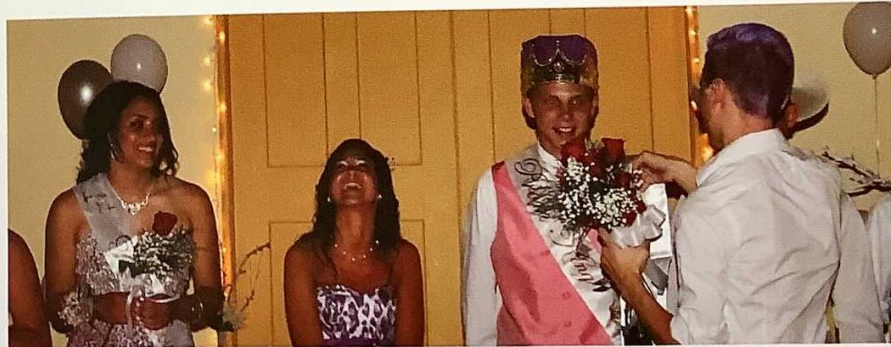
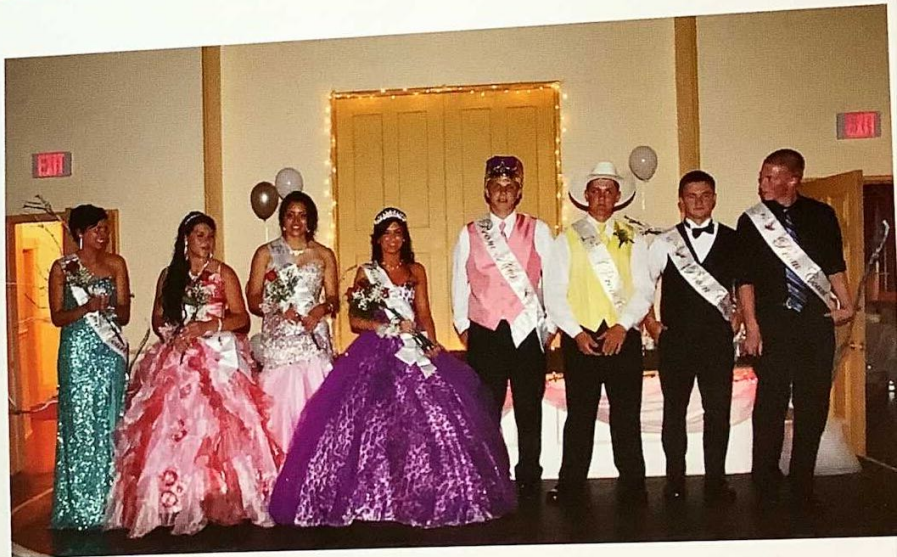
This brick is the brain for a Lego robot that the students construct and then learn to program.
