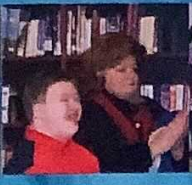

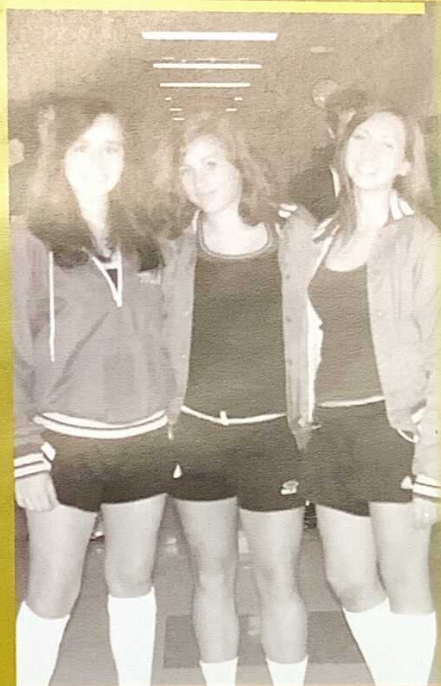

**Mrs. Norine Ryan.**

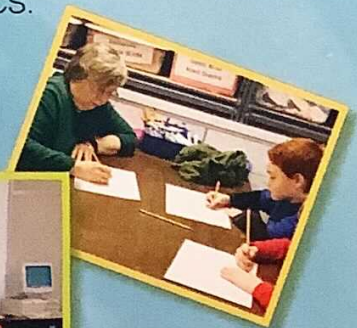

I would like to thank the athletes, parents, administration, community and fans for your continuous support throughout the year in making this season a success.

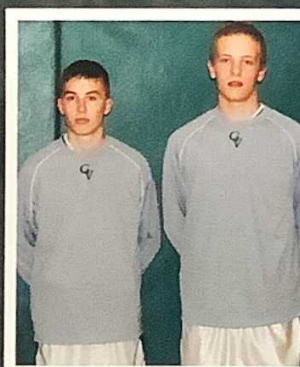

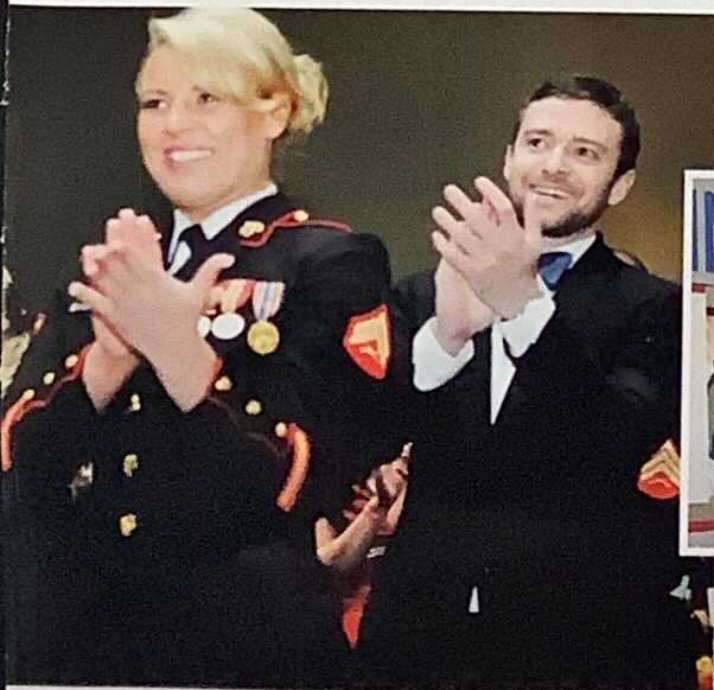

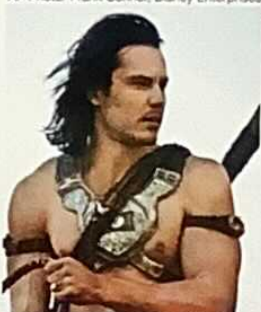

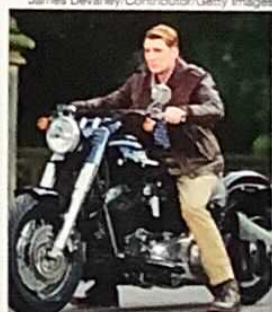
