Unit 1: Routines and Foundational Skills

At a Glance: Students will learn and practice the routines for writing and reading literacy centers.

Timeline: 10 Days

Unit 2: Narratives

At a Glance: Students will explore the narrative genre, focused primarily on personal narratives and small moment stories.

Timeline: 25 Days

Unit 3: Opinion

At a Glance: Students will develop their own opinions and write about them with strong supporting details.

Timeline: 25 Days

Unit 4: Folktales and Fairy Tales

At a Glance: Students will participate in collaborative conversations about fairy tales and folktales. Students will compare and contrast two characters within a narrative text. Students will write their own fairy tales.

Timeline: 25 Days

Unit 5: Nonfiction

At a Glance: Students will explore the genre of nonfiction. Students will learn about nonfiction text structures and features and write their own informational reports. Students will learn about notable people in history by studying biographies. Students will compare texts and identify main ideas in informational texts.

Timeline: 30 Days

Unit 6: Poetry

At a Glance: Students will explore the genre of poetry and learn the following terms: rhyme, rhythm, repetition, mood and emotion. Students will learn about the structure of poems and will read and write various types of poems.

Timeline: 25 Days

Unit 7: Comics/Graphic Novels Mini Unit

At a Glance: Students will explore the genre of comics and graphic novels.
