ABOUT THE CLUB:

The club will schedule as many trips as the weather and finances allow. The trips are normally scheduled for either Friday evenings after school or Saturdays from morning until evening. The time schedule for a typical trip would be as follows:

There will be chaperones on the busses, however, **it must be understood that each student will be on his/her own while at the resort.** Students will assume responsibility for equipment, conduct, and injuries while skiing. **(It is strongly recommended that beginners take a lesson at the reduced group rate).** Chaperones will monitor the ski patrol area for injuries and will be notified of any misconduct reported by staff members at the resort.

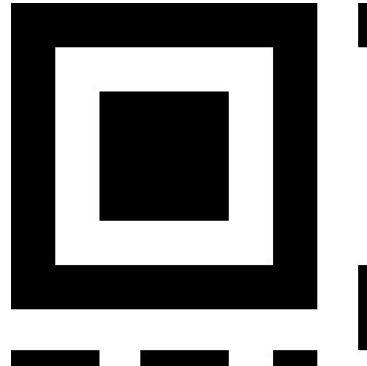
The trips are arranged to take advantage of group discounts offered by various resorts. The **tentative** prices for the trips are as follows.
