During her years at Seneca Valley High School,  
there were only three sports offered for females  
and freshmen could not earn a varsity letter.

Only permitted to play 10 games per season.

Girls' basketball played a half-court game only and  
players were restricted to three dribbles per possession.

Cathy (Black) Beighey was a pioneer student-athlete  
for Seneca Valley.

She earned three varsity letters for girls' basketball as a guard.

In her senior year in 1969-70,  
she scored 41% of the team's points with a total of 118.

Seneca Valley was in its 6<sup>th</sup> year as a high school,  
and it was the most successful girls' basketball team  
to date in school history.
