Swimming

During Stacie's senior season at Seneca Valley High School in 2005, she took home 4 WPIAL medals, 2 PIAA Bronze Medals and swam as part of the State Champion 200 Medley Relay team. Coached by Tom Donati, Stacie hit the ground running as a freshman with the Raiders as she qualified for both the WPIAL and PIAA Meets. By the time she was finished at Seneca Valley, she was decorated with 16 WPIAL Medals, 9 PIAA Medals, and was named both an All-State and All-American Swimmer. Stacie set numerous school records throughout her career and is still the Seneca Valley record holder for three girls' swimming events: the 200 Medley Relay, the 50 Freestyle and the 100 Freestyle. Stacie continued her swimming career at the University of Pittsburgh where she qualified for the NCAA meet as a freshman, competed in the 2008 Olympic Trials, earned All-Big East Honors and set several team records.
