During high school Peet led the Raiders in lacrosse and capped his scholastic career by setting a W.P.I.A.L. record with 410 career goals. Poillon was named Western PA Player of the Year and a U.S. Lacrosse All-American in 2005. Peet attended Howard Community College where he was a two-time First Team All-American and Conference Player of the Year. He then finished his collegiate career playing at Ohio State University and University of Maryland - Baltimore County. He was then picked 20th overall in the Major League Lacrosse Draft and signed to the Boston Cannons. Peet to return to Seneca Valley in 2011 and lead the Raiders to their first W.P.I.A.L. Championship as the team's head coach. After two seasons with the Raiders, Peet then moved on to coach at the Division I level with a position first with the University of Delaware.
